Ignitable Liquids Reference Collection (ILRC)

Ignitable Liquid Samples

Sample volumes of 400µl are adsorbed onto a half gram of activated charcoal contained in ½ dram vials. These are reference materials, so there are no associated certificates of analysis. Safety data sheets (SDS) are available on the ILRC database.

Sample Ordering Procedures

Samples are prepared upon receipt of the order and acceptance of any purchase order terms and conditions.
